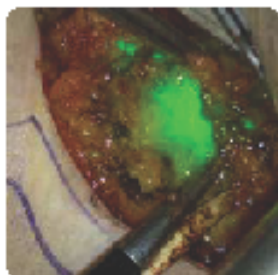

He is a recognized leader in healthcare innovation, having received multiple prestigious awards including the National Healthcare Innovation Award (2018, 2024), the Mochtar Riady Pinnacle Award (2018), the HIMSS Davies Award of Excellence (2020), and the Hospital Management Asia GOLD Award (2024). He currently holds key leadership roles as Chairman of the Chapter of Intensive Care Medicine in Singapore and Vice-Chair of the Rapid Response Society since 2024.

Dr Faheem has pioneered advancements such as ICU outreach services and automated Code Blue systems using IT-driven protocols and is deeply involved in teaching as a faculty member and examiner for MRCEM (UK), NUS/LKC Medicine, and courses like BASIC, ACLS, and CICM. With over SGD 1.7 million in active research grants, his projects include VITAL SCOUT, post-ICU clinics, and tele-ventilator systems. He has authored more than 25 peer-reviewed publications in leading journals such as Resuscitation, Annals of Internal Medicine, and the American Journal of Emergency Medicine, focusing on areas like AI/ML in outcome prediction, sepsis, non-invasive ventilation monitoring, and post-ICU care. His work emphasizes integrating digital technologies in healthcare, including the "ICU Without Walls" concept, smart escalation tools using NEWS II, automated vital-sign alerts, and EPIC system integration, with research interests spanning post-ICU syndromes, clinical deterioration detection, smart ward wearables, and predictive analytics using AI/ML.

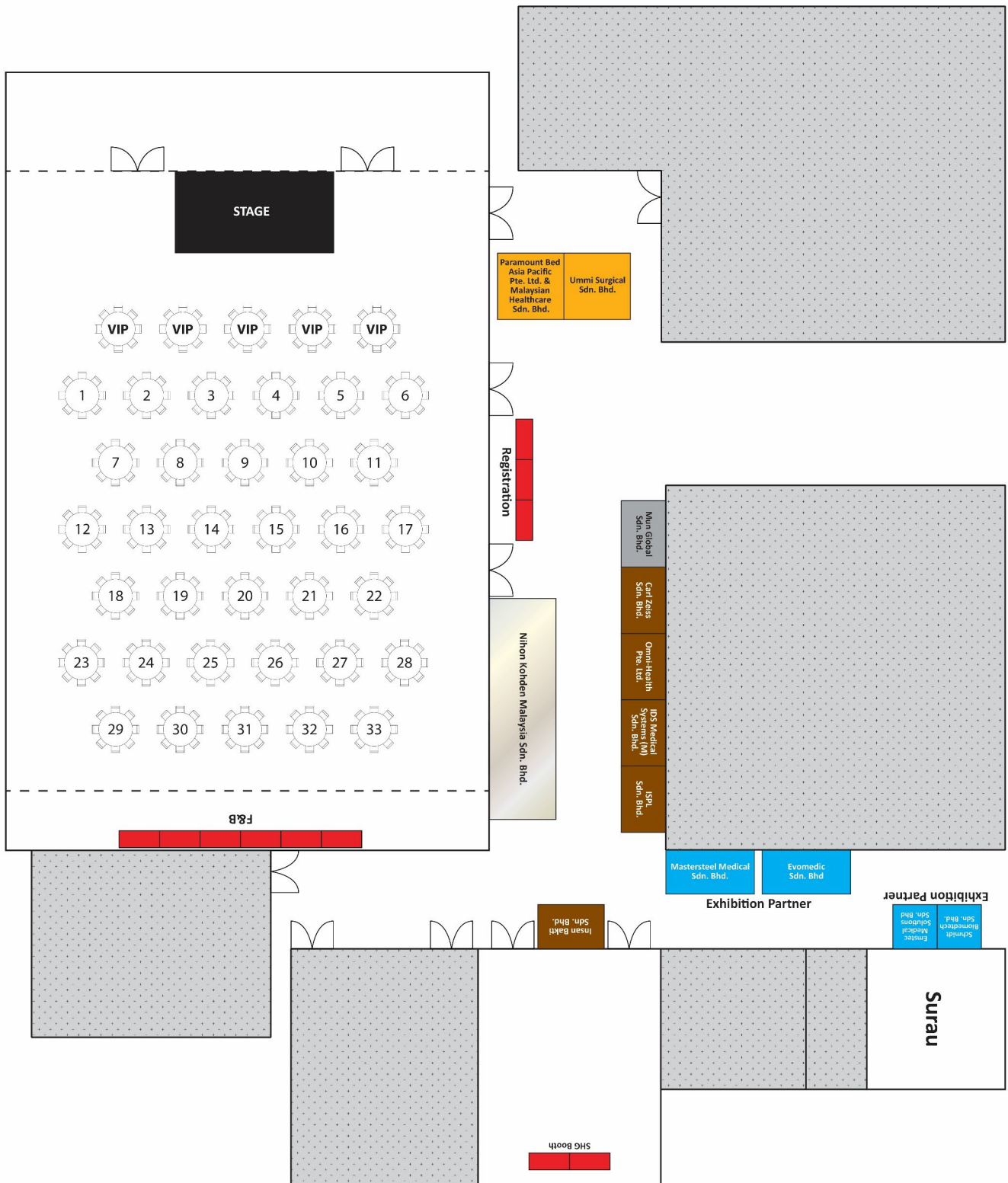

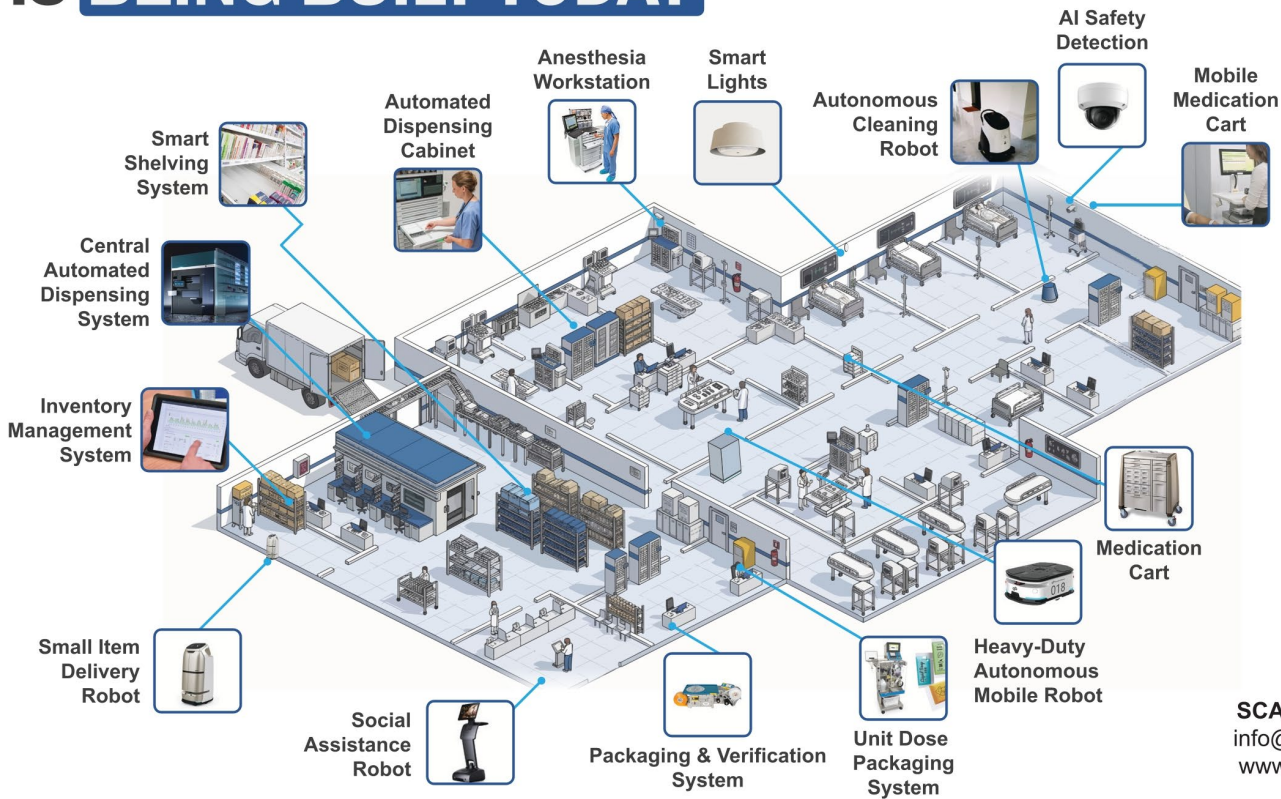

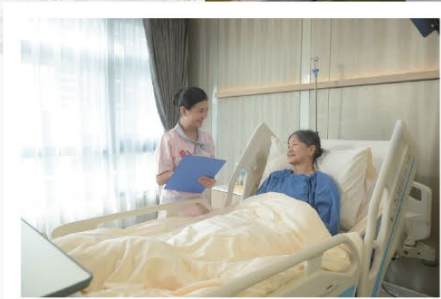
